Meeting Time and Place

- 3. Jim Myers called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Ann Wiles motioned and Josh Young seconded to approve the consent agenda, consisting of:

  - D. Approve offering teaching contracts to Wendy Budde and Tracey Baker for summer school from June 1<sup>st</sup> to June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
  - E. Approve offering a para contract to Alannah West for summer school from June 1<sup>st</sup> to June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Construction Manager At Risk

4. Andy Fahrmeier, Hutton, presented the change order for the construction project. The change was due to adding the cafeteria flooring project. The original guaranteed maximum price was \$1,196,950. The guaranteed maximum price will be increased by this change order in the amount of \$60,962 due to the

flooring project. The flooring project includes the demolition, replacing the door thresholds, the floor finish, and detailed cleaning after completion of the project. Mr. Fahrmeier will also bid out painting the cafeteria, which is not included in the price.

- 11. Brian Gerstberger motioned and Jason Koehn seconded to approve budget cuts 1 through 8 as presented in executive session. Motion passed 5 to 2, with Jim Myers and Josh Young voting against the motion.
- 12. The budget cuts are as follows:
- A. Eliminate a 4<sup>th</sup> grade teaching position for 2021-22 resulting in one class of about 25 fourth grade students.
- B. Adjust maintenance director salary with new hire.
- C. Eliminate half of a sixth grade teaching position for 2021-22 resulting in one class of 27 sixth grade students for the first semester.
- D. Forfeit Southwest Plains eWalk-Through tool and KESA support.
- E. Eliminate a para position at the JSHS.
- F. Forego replacing an elementary library para and use current library staff to cover in both buildings.
- G. Reduce to one JH Wrestling head coach.
- H. Reduce to one Cross Country head coach.
- 13. Jim Myers officially adjourned the meeting at 8:00 p.m.
