Revenue Neutral Rate

4. Resolution No. 2025-10 was presented. The resolution expresses the property taxation policy of USD 467 Wichita County with respect to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Tax Rate for financing the annual budget for 2024-2025. Whereas, 2021 SB 13 and Senate Sub for HB 2104, provides that a levy of property taxes to finance the 2024-2025 budget of USD 467 exceeds the Revenue Neutral Tax Rate to finance the 2024-2025 budget of USD 467, be authorized by a resolution. Now, therefore, be it resolved by USD 467 that the 2024-2025 budget with a levy of property taxes exceeding the Revenue Neutral Tax Rates calculated for 2024-2025, as adjusted pursuant to 2021 SB 13 and Senate Sub for HB 2104 is hereby adopted for the following funds: General, Capital Outlay, Bond and Interest Funds. Adopted this 9th day of September, 2024, by Unified School District No. 467, Wichita County, Kansas.
